Bootstrap was created by [Mark Otto](#) and [Jacob Thornton](#) in 2011. It is a front-end framework for HTML and CSS, based on the [Twitter](#) design system. It is designed to be easy to use and to be highly customizable. It is also designed to be responsive, meaning it can be used to create websites that work on all devices, from desktop computers to smartphones. Bootstrap was released as an open-source project in 2011 and has since become one of the most popular front-end frameworks in the world. It is used by millions of developers to create websites and web applications. Bootstrap 4 was released in 2018 and Bootstrap 5 was released in 2021.
