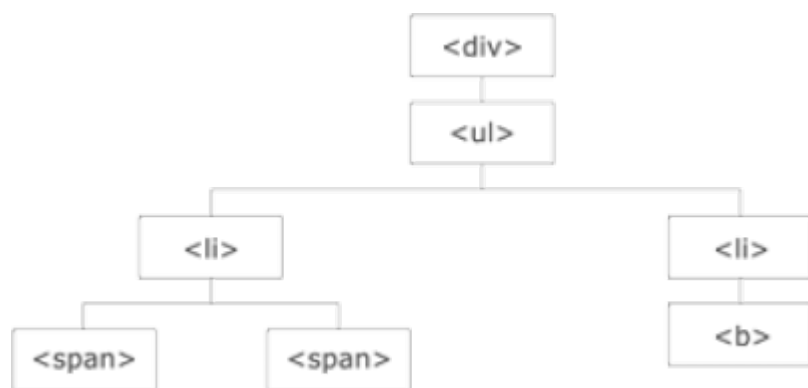


Illustration explained
